

Brooks Four-Ball Match Play - Pool Play 9-hole matches Handicap Conversion Instructions

Pool Play (9-hole match): Handicap indexes, of the day of play, must be used for the competition. Each player's handicap index must be converted to a 9-hole handicap from the tees that they are playing. The tees played must be the tees that they most frequently play. Once all four players' handicaps have been converted, the player(s) with the lowest handicap will be reduced to scratch (zero handicap). The other players' handicaps will be reduced by the same difference.

Example: 9-hole pool play on Springbrook's front 9

Name	Tee	Index	Converted 9-hole handicap	Adjusted 9-hole handicap
Jim	Gold	8.6	5	3
John	Blue	19.7	10	8
Sam	White	23.2	10	8
Susie	Green	6.4	2	0

Susie had the lowest converted 9-hole handicap of the group. Susie was reduced to play at scratch (zero) and the other players' handicaps were reduced by two strokes.

Once adjusted handicaps have been established, they are applied to the handicap holes on the scorecard. Being a 9-hole match, the handicap holes are ranked 1-9.
